
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the 3rd - 5th Respondents are hereby restrained from arresting, detaining and harassing the Applicant pending the determination of the Motion on Notice.
2. That the 1st and 2nd Respondents are restrained from using the 3rd - 5th Respondents to arrest, detain, harass and intimidate the Applicant pending the determination of the Motion on Notice.
3. That the 3rd - 5th Respondents should without delay unconditionally withdraw the men and officers of the Nigeria Police Force from the premises of the Applicant pending the determination of the Motion on Notice.
4. That leave is granted to the Applicant to serve the 1st Respondent through the office of the Niger Delta Development Commission situate at NDDC Head Office, Aba Road, Port Harcourt, Rivers State and the 4th - 5th Respondents through the office of the 3rd Respondent situate at Nigeria Police Force, Rivers State

Command Headquarters, Moscow Road, Port Harcourt, Rivers State.

5. That the matter is adjourned to the 27th July 2020 for hearing.
